The inherent risks of skiing and ski racing are hereby defined, but not limited to these definitions, as those dangers of conditions which are integral part of the part of the sport of skiing, whether natural, man-made, or man modified – including, but not limited to, changing weather conditions, variation or steepness of terrain and race course design, snow ice conditions, surface or subsurface conditions, bare spots, creeks, gullies, forest growth or rocks, stumps, lift towers and other structures and their components, collisions with other skiers and racers, collisions with other obstacles and racing gates, and a skier's or racer's failure to ski within the skier's own ability. Such inherent risks can result in personal bodily injury, including death and/or property damage.
